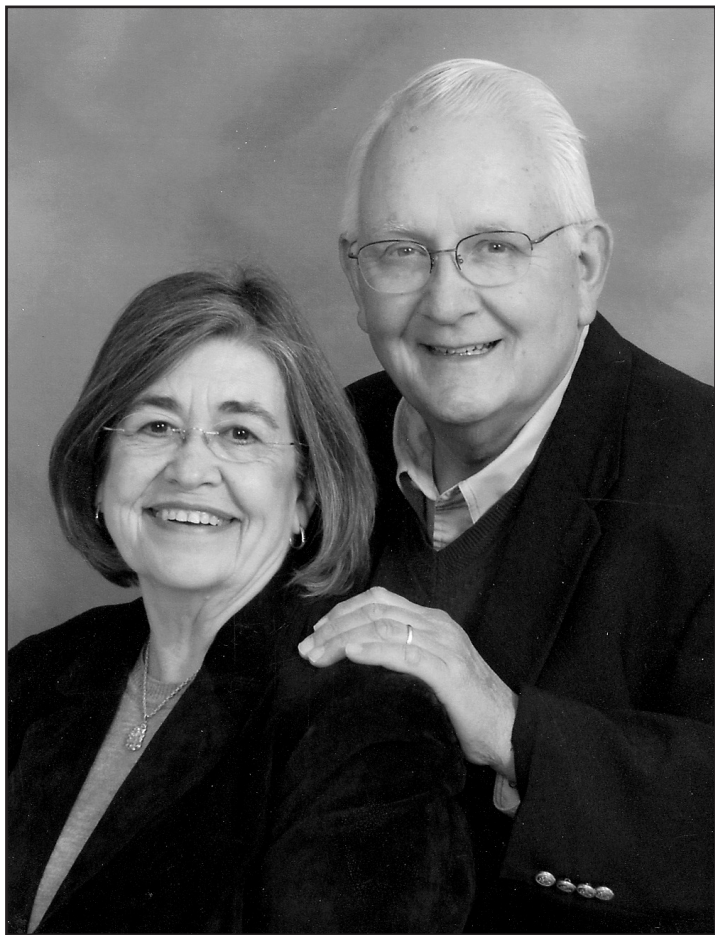


50th Wedding Anniversary
